William Beranek, Jr. received his undergraduate education at University of Wisconsin, majoring in chemistry. He has a Ph.D. in chemistry from the California Institute of Technology. He spent two years doing postdoctoral biochemical research at the Duke University Medical Center and two years as staff officer for a National Academy of Sciences Bicentennial project projecting historical science impact on economic development to the future.

Since 1975, he has worked in Indiana on public policy. He specializes in nonpartisan policy analysis of state and local environmental issues which have a technical component. He is currently President of the Indiana Environmental Institute, Inc., a neutral, third-party forum for analysis and mutual understanding of options for Indiana environmental protection laws, rules and policies.
