



**Dr. Garth Boyd**

Since October, 2007, Dr. Garth Boyd has been with Camco Global, a carbon credit aggregation and project development firm that is publicly traded on the London Stock Exchange. Camco's North American office is in Denver but Garth resides in North Carolina. For the previous year and a half, Garth was with CMA Consulting, LLC, opening a NC office for a firm headquartered in Kansas City, Missouri, that provides various services to animal agriculture industry organizations, agribusiness companies and food retailers. Previous involvement in the NC pork industry includes serving as director of environmental technology for Smithfield Foods from 2001-2006. Prior to working with Smithfield Foods, Garth was director of land and nutrient management for Murphy Farms, where he led that company into the era of on-farm environmental training, auditing, certification and stewardship. He was a two term member of the United States Department of Agriculture's Agriculture Air Quality Task Force, as well as a member of the NC GreenPower board. His civic activities include commissioner for the town of Topsail Beach and member of the Wilmington Committee of 100 board. Prior to living in NC, Garth lived in Colorado, where he was on the animal science faculty at Colorado State University. In addition to serving on the NC Pork Council's board for two terms, Garth is a member of the research committee.
